## **RULES FOR THE RACE**

To qualify for entry in the Olney Pancake Race competitors must be women of 18 years of age or older and have lived in the town of Olney for at least 3 months prior to the event or, if living away, have their permanent home in the town, or work in Olney. You can run as an individual or as part of a team with two or three others.

This is an historic Race so we ask you to wear the traditional costume of a skirt, apron, and head scarf, together with the race t-shirt. Please note only Race sponsorship logos are permitted. In addition, you must carry a frying pan containing a pancake.

You need to provide your skirt and a pancake – these are essential items, and you won't be able to run without them!

<u>Please be at Race Control in the marquee on the Market Place at 11.00 am.</u> You can collect your t-shirt etc and then publicity photographs will be taken prior to the start. We will also have a runners' warm-up. The Race will start from the Market Place at 11.55am.

The starter first tells the runners to 'toss their pancakes' and then starts the Race with the Pancake Bell. At the finish the fastest runner is required to toss her pancake before being declared the winner. *Continued overleaf* 

## All runners are required to attend the Shriving Service in the Church immediately after the Race.

The winner's prize and prize from Liberal are presented during the service.

The second and third prizes and goody bags for every runner will be given out at the end of the service; please wait at the back of the church. The winner receives £100, second £50 and third £25.

The race winner is required to join us for a brief video call with Liberal, Kansas in the evening. Liberal run their own Pancake Race and we compare the winning times with them at the end of their Shriving Service, to declare the international winner who wins an additional prize of £100; this challenge dates back to 1950.

Please note that there is no general evening event this year.

We hope to attract publicity for the Race both immediately afterwards and in the following year to promote the Race for 2027; this means that photographs and video will be taken throughout the event.

## Please note, all entrants take part in the race at their own risk.
